Arrival in Paris – the capital of France and the Largest City. Enjoy the Seine Cruise in the evening. Overnight accommodation in Paris.




# Day 02 - PARIS CITY TOUR - 03rd LEVEL EIFFEL TOWER - FRAGONARD MUSEUM

Today enjoy Paris with an English-speaking guide, the tour includes views of Alexander Bridge, Arc de Triomphe, Concorde Square, Opera House, Invalides and Champs Elysees. Next visit to the top of the world - famous Eiffel Tower. The Eiffel Tower is a wrought-iron lattice tower on the Champ de Mars in Paris, France. It is named after the engineer Gustave Eiffel, whose company designed and built the tower. Later visit Fragonard Perfume Museum. The Fragonard perfumery is one of the oldest perfumeries in Grasse. It is located in the centre of the city. It was founded in 1926 by a former Parisian notary, Eugène Fuchs, in one of the oldest factories in the city, originally built by perfumer Claude Mottet in 1841

Overnight accommodation in Paris.

#### Day 03 - DISNEYLAND & LIDO

Today is all about fun. Proceed to visit the one and only Disneyland! Get a chance to meet the childhood heroes such Micky Mouse, Donald Duck, Pluto the dog, Goofy and so on. Disneyland Paris, formerly Euro Disney Resort, is an entertainment resort in Chessy, France, a new town located 32 km east of the centre of Paris. No trip to Paris can end without a taste of Paris's famous cabaret show at Lido de Paris. Le Lido is a cabaret and burlesque show located on the Champs-Élysées in Paris, France. It is known for its exotic shows including dancers, singers, and other performers.

Overnight accommodation in Paris.

Day 04 - PARIS - BRUSSELS - AMSTERDAM

PARIS - BRUSSELS: 320km - Approx. 4.5 hours drive by coach depending on traffic conditions BRUSSELS - AMSTERDAM: 210km - Approx. 3.25 hours drive by coach depending on traffic conditions

Today drive to Brussels capital of Belgium. View the adorable 'Manneken Pis' statue of a little boy, as well as the beautiful Grand Place. Manneken Pis is a landmark 61 cm bronze fountain sculpture in the centre of Brussels, depicting a naked little boy urinating into the fountain's basin. It was designed by Jérôme Duquesnoy the Elder and put in place in 1618 or 1619. The current statue is a replica which dates from 1965. Next, we stop to photograph the iconic Atomium structure of an Ion Molecule magnified 150 billion times. The Atomium is a landmark building in Brussels, originally constructed for the 1958 Brussels World Expo. It is located on the Heysel Plateau, where the exhibition took place. It is now a museum. Designed by the engineer André Waterkeyn and architects André and Jean Polak, it stands 102 m tall. Later we proceed to Amsterdam – the capital of Netherlands. Overnight accommodation in Amsterdam.

#### Day 05 – AMSTERDAM CITY TOUR – CANAL CRUISE – HEINEKEN

Today we spend some free time in Dam Square – the heart of Amsterdam. Dam Square or Dam is a town square in Amsterdam, the capital of the Netherlands. Its notable buildings and frequent events make it one of the most wellknown and important locations in the city and the country. Proceed for the Orientation tour of Amsterdam. Later enjoy a Cruise on the Canals of Amsterdam in a glass-topped boat. Visit Heineken Museum – which is a historic brewery and corporate visitor center for the internationally distributed Dutch pilsner, Heineken beer. Overnight accommodation in Amsterdam.

# Day 06 - MADURODAM / KEUKENHOF - ZAANSE SCHANS

AMSTERDAM - MADURODAM: 63km each way - Approx. 1 hour 20 min drive by coach each way depending on traffic AMSTERDAM - ZAANSE SCHANS: 23km each way - Approx. 45 min drive by coach each way depending on traffic

Today, we drive to Netherlands. On arrival visit the Keukenhof Tulip Gardens - the world's most beautiful spring garden. Keukenhof, also known as the Garden of Europe, is one of the world's largest flower gardens, situated in the town of Lisse. OR Visit Madurodam, home to famous Dutch Landmarks built on a 1:25 scale. Madurodam is a miniature park and tourist attraction in the Scheveningen district of The Hague in the Netherlands. Next visit Zaanse Schans, a living open air Dutch Village and Museum. Historic windmills and distinctive green wooden houses were relocated here to recreate the look of an 18th/19th-century village.

Overnight accommodation in Amsterdam.
