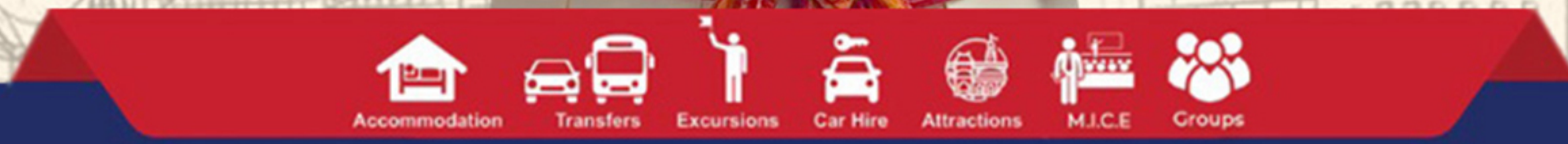

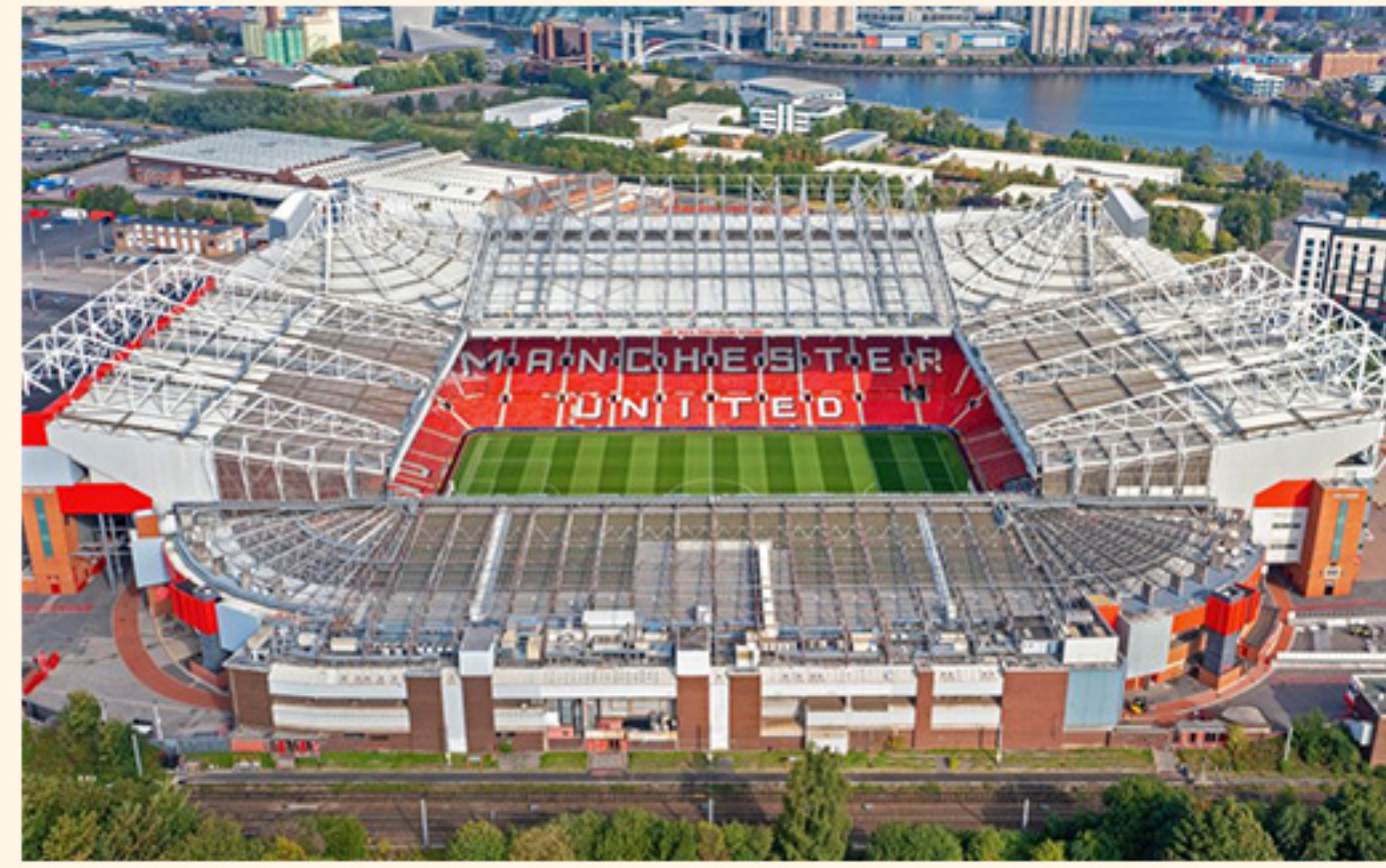

Glengoyne is distilled more slowly than any other malt whisky. it is situated at Dumgoyne, on the south-western edge of the Scottish Highlands, close to Loch Lomond and to the north of Glasgow. Although distilled in the Highlands, making Glengoyne a Highland single malt, the whisky is matured in the Lowlands.

It is renowned for its stunning natural beauty and diverse wildlife. As the largest freshwater lake in Britain by surface area, Loch Lomond draws visitors from around the world, attracted by the sweeping landscapes, myriad activities, and rich history. On this excursion, you would get a chance to enjoy a scenic cruise on Loch Lomond. After the Tour, we will have lunch at the Local Indian Restaurant.

Later you will continue to Fort William and enjoy the Nevis Range Gondola Mountain experience. It is the tallest mountain across the British Isles, beating the next tallest, Ben Macdui, by around 100ft. It is the tallest peak anywhere at 700km, crossing the North Sea to the west coast of Norway (Melderskin). The gondola (cable car) is a fantastic experience, and you get a great view of the Great Glen (valley) and of Ben Nevis. After an exciting day, you will proceed to Inverness to enjoy a delicious dinner at the local restaurant.

After Breakfast, Proceed for a day trip to the Isle of Skye. The Isle of Skye offers some of Scotland's most spectacular scenery. The soaring peaks of the Cuillin Hills, the dramatic geology of the Old Man of Storr and The Quiraing, an extraordinary assembly of pinnacles, rock towers and secret places. It is connected to Scotland's northwest coast by bridge and is known for its rugged landscapes, picturesque fishing villages and medieval castles. The largest island in the Inner Hebrides archipelago, it has an indented coastline of peninsulas and narrow lochs, radiating out from a mountainous interior. The town of Portree, a base for exploring the island, features harbor-side pubs and boutiques. After the Tour, we will have lunch at the Local Restaurant.

Later you will visit Dunvegan Castle & Gardens on the Isle of Skye.

Dunvegan Castle is the oldest continuously inhabited castle in Scotland and has been the ancestral home of the Chiefs of clan MacLeod for 800 years. Originally designed as a fortress to keep people out, today you can tour an award-winning castle and Highland estate steeped in history and clan legend, delight in the beauty of its formal gardens, take a boat trip (if opted) to see the Loch Dunvegan seal colony, browse in one of the shops which feature quality local and Scottish gifts or satisfy your appetite at the MacLeod Tables Cafe.

After an exciting day, you will proceed back to Inverness to Enjoy a delicious Dinner at the Local Restaurant.

Hear of the folklore and firm believers in the legend of the Loch Ness Monster, which is said to swim in the shimmering waters. After the Tour, we will have lunch at the Local Restaurant.

Later you will Visit the Stirling Castle.

Stirling Castle is arguably one of the most important places in Scotland. a must-see for anyone interested in Scottish history and castles, as it is a very complete castle with very recognizable residents. It is located in Stirling, is one of the largest and most historically and architecturally important castles in Scotland. The castle sits atop an intrusive crag, which forms part of the Stirling Sill geological formation.

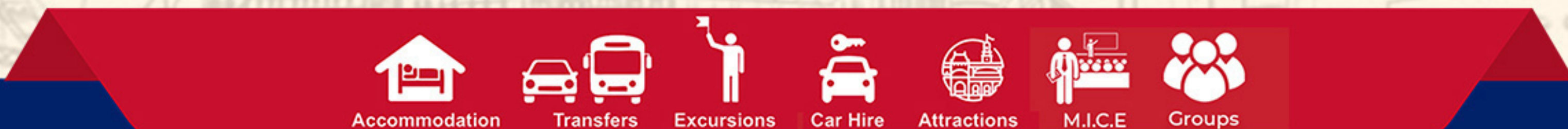
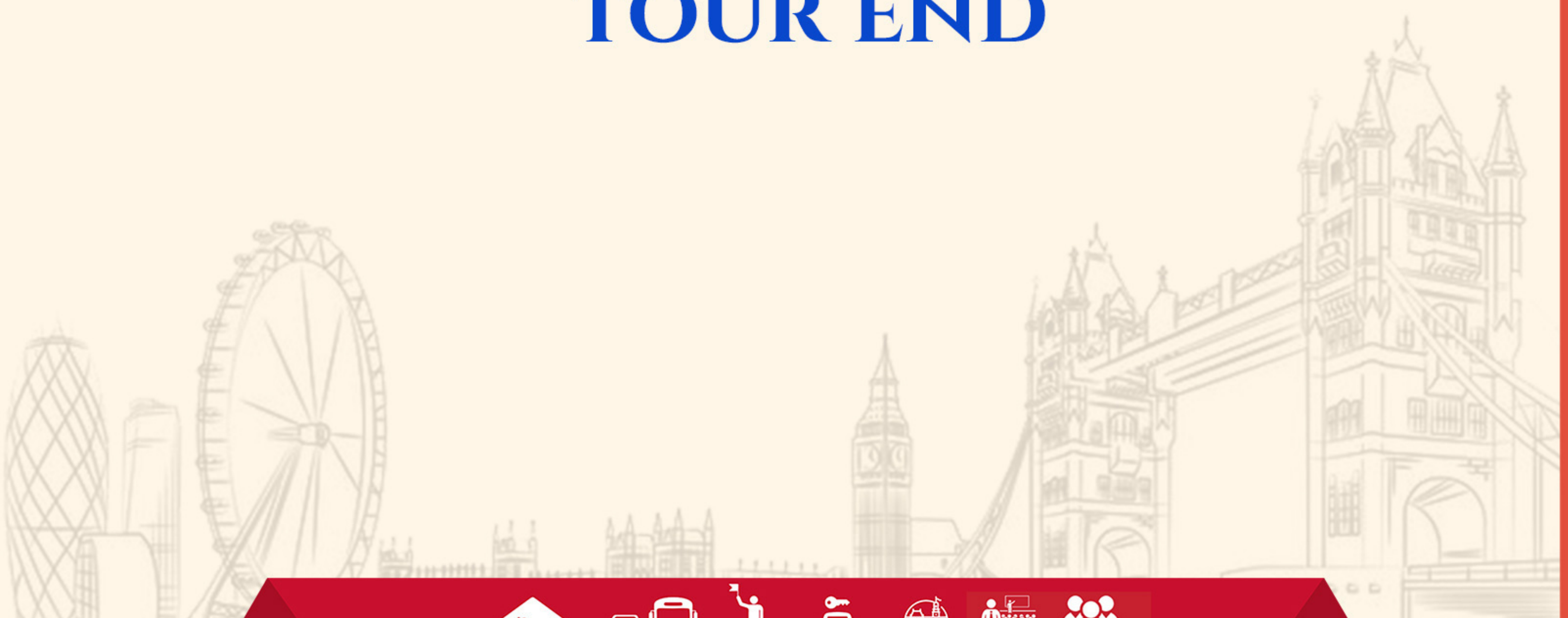
